Quick Hits

- For the 3rd straight season, the Marlins have qualified for the Petitt Cup Championship series. They've won the previous two titles and look to become the second team in CPL history to win 3 straight Petitt Cups. (High Point-Thomasville, 2006-08).
- The Marlins swept the Peninsula Pilots in the first round, outscoring the Pilots 16-3 in the two games. The Marlins hit 6 home runs in the two games, and only issued 2 walks the entire series.
- Jack Harris (Newberry) leads the CPL in home runs with 16, and he led the East in RBI (42). The Marlins are 19-3 at home this year, and are 45-5 in their last 50 home games dating back to 2019.
- This is the 2nd ever meeting between the Marlins and Bananas. The first was in the Bananas' inaugural season in 2016, and they beat the Fish 12-3 at The Rock. Savannah won their only Petitt Cup that yr.
