KEY STORYLINES

REELIN' IN THE YEARS

The Marlins return for their 16th season in the Coastal Plain League. This year also marks the sixth under Head Coach Sam Carel, the winningest in Marlins history, who is in his second stint with the team. Carel led Morehead City to two Pettit Cup Playoff appearances in his first two seasons back.

REFLECTING ON 2025

Last Season, the Marlins finished 4th place in the East Division with a final record of 21-24. Morehead City was led by four All-CPL team players Tanner Malley (Western Michigan), Nate Anderson (Kennesaw State), Reid Bertram (Gardner-Webb), and Danny Thompson (UNC Greensboro).

MOREHEAD CITY PREVIEW

With a litany of returning players, the Marlins are poised for a successful 2026 campaign. Look out for some powerful bats and dominant pitching this season thanks to your favorite Morehead City stars. With Head Coach Sam Carel back at the helm alongside Jaylen Mack and Gabe Todtenhausen, a rising star among pitching coaches, the team looks to be as strong as ever in Big Rock.

STARTING PITCHER PREVIEW

Owen Schneider will make his second start of the season for the Marlins tonight against the Chili Peppers. The lefty starter made his Marlins debut on June 3rd in Macon, going for three innings while allowing four hits and two runs. Schneider registered a 3.48 ERA at Missouri Southern State, recording 95.2 innings pitched across 16 starts as the lead arm for the Lions. Schneider previously pitched for the O'Fallon Hoots in the Prospect League in 2024 and 2025.

MARLINS POUNCE LATE AGAINST THE DOGZ

Once again the Marlins exploded late in the game, putting up four runs in the 7th and one in the 8th to take a 6-2 lead over Zebulon. The bullpen shined, combining for 17 strikeouts led by James Brock with 10, who also earned CPL Pitcher of the Night. Six of the Marlins bats recorded multiple hits, led by Bray Touchstone with three, and Jovan Gill with two doubles.

THE HAYNES TRAIN

Jakob Haynes is on a tear to start the year. The catcher has done well behind the plate, working nicely with the Marlins CPL leading pitching staff. The Claridge, Pennsylvania, native also has a hit in every game this season, with more multi-hit games registered than not. Over the last two games, Haynes has a combined five hits, two runs, one RBI, and two strikeouts. The Seton Hill backstop is now up to a .462 batting average this season, tied for the second best in the CPL.

LAST MEETING WITH THE PEPPERS

The Fish made the drive up to Tri-City on Sunday, their first of three trips this summer. Charlie Richwine impressed with eight strikeouts across four innings, earning the win for Tri-City. Aidan Newton had difficulty locating, walking six in 1.2 IP, which was compounded by errors in the field. The Peppers had a big five-run 2nd featuring back-to-back homers from JT Brown and Conner Moore, which would be enough to seal a 6-2 loss for the Fish.
