KEY STORYLINES

REELIN' IN THE YEARS

The Marlins return for their 16th season in the Coastal Plain League. This year also marks the sixth under Head Coach Sam Carel, the winningest in Marlins history, who is in his second stint with the team. Carel led Morehead City to two Petitt Cup Playoff appearances in his first two seasons back.

REFLECTING ON 2025

Last Season, the Marlins finished 4th place in the East Division with a final record of 21-24. Morehead City was led by four All-CPL team players Tanner Malley (Western Michigan), Nate Anderson (Kennesaw State), Reid Bertram (Gardner-Webb), and Danny Thompson (UNC Greensboro).

MOREHEAD CITY PREVIEW

With a litany of returning players, the Marlins are poised for a successful 2026 campaign. Look out for some powerful bats and dominant pitching this season thanks to your favorite Morehead City stars. With Head Coach Sam Carel back at the helm alongside Jaylen Mack and Gabe Todtenhausen, a rising star among pitching coaches, the team looks to be as strong as ever in Big Rock.

STARTING PITCHER PREVIEW

Spencer Cipro will make his first start of the season tonight in Hampton. The Belmont Abbey righty is a third-year Marlin and four-year CPL veteran with a 2.45 ERA in his 3.2 innings of work. Cipro was one of the top arms for the Crusaders this spring, recording a 3.62 ERA in 82 innings, with a 10-1 record in 14 starts.

SHARKS SNAP WIN STREAK

Morehead City's 10-game winning streak was spoiled by the Sharks last night, taking it 11-3 in Big Rock. Morehead City grabbed an early lead in the 1st, but the Sharks quickly rebounded to take a 4-1 lead. Both sides went back-and-forth in the 5th, but Wilmington continued to slowly add insurance runs, with three each in the 6th and 9th.

KORY WITH A K

Right-handed pitcher Kory Williams has dominated on the mound, now with the second-highest strikeout total on the season at 23. Williams also has the lowest WHIP at 0.78, the only pitcher who is sub-one at this point in the season. His reliably great starts have allowed Morehead City to hold teams down and get an early jump on the scoreboard.

LAST MEETING WITH PENINSULA

The last meeting with the Pilots was a 15-1 win for the Marlins, a particularly impressive night for the top of the order. Grant Russo, Ronnie Rowley, and Sebastian Mexico all reached safely their first few trips to the plate, ending the night with seven hits, nine runs, four RBIs, and two walks as a trio. Kory Williams gave up just two hits and one run over four innings, while Reid Bertram, Sage Ferguson, Spencer Cipro, and Matthew Heard all held the Pilots scoreless.
